Preparing for Research

Topic selection, approval, proposal and preliminary research

Access Resources

Collect a variety of resources and locate necessary information from each

Process Information

Use resources to compile student-written report and presentation data

Transfer Learning

Revise report & presentation, compile a list of sources (bibliography), and prepare for presentations

In-Class Presentations

Three minute (single student; 2 minutes per additional student) in-class presentations highlighting the “best of” or “meat & potatoes” of the project that should include information from both written & visual elements of the project. Students will be expected to *present, inform and enlighten* their audience; not *read* their project!

School Fair

The Historica project will culminate with the school fair during the morning of February 22. All projects will be setup in the gym during the afternoon of February 21 in time for an Open House for parents and other family members to view the project during the evening. Students are responsible for ensuring all required presentation material & audio/video equipment is pre-arranged! Various teachers will adjudicate projects during the fair. Parents and junior classes will be invited view the fair. Top rated projects will be invited to participate in Regional Fair at the Parkwood Estates in Oshawa on May 1-2, 2008.
