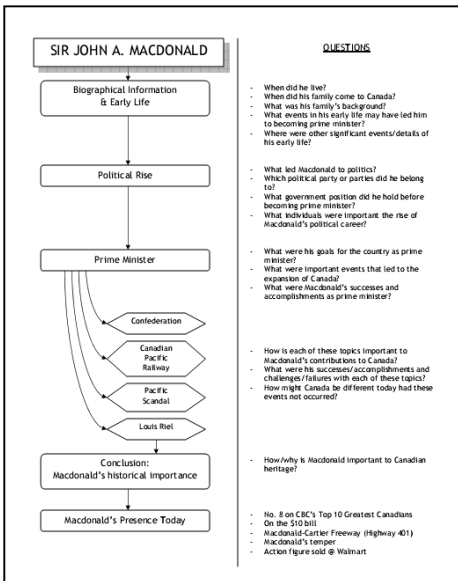
By each student:
